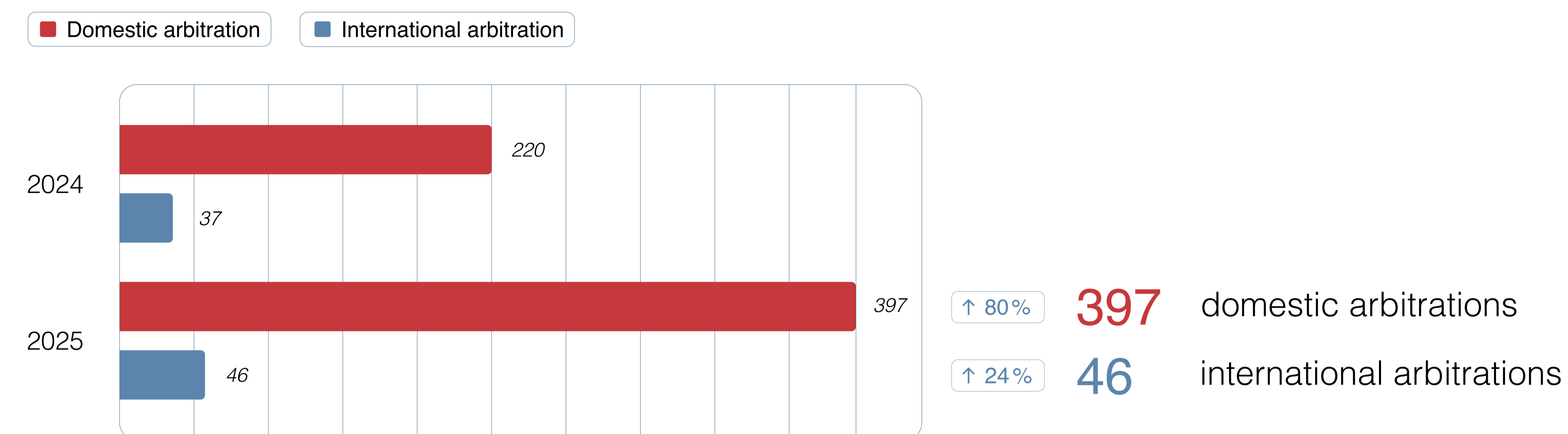

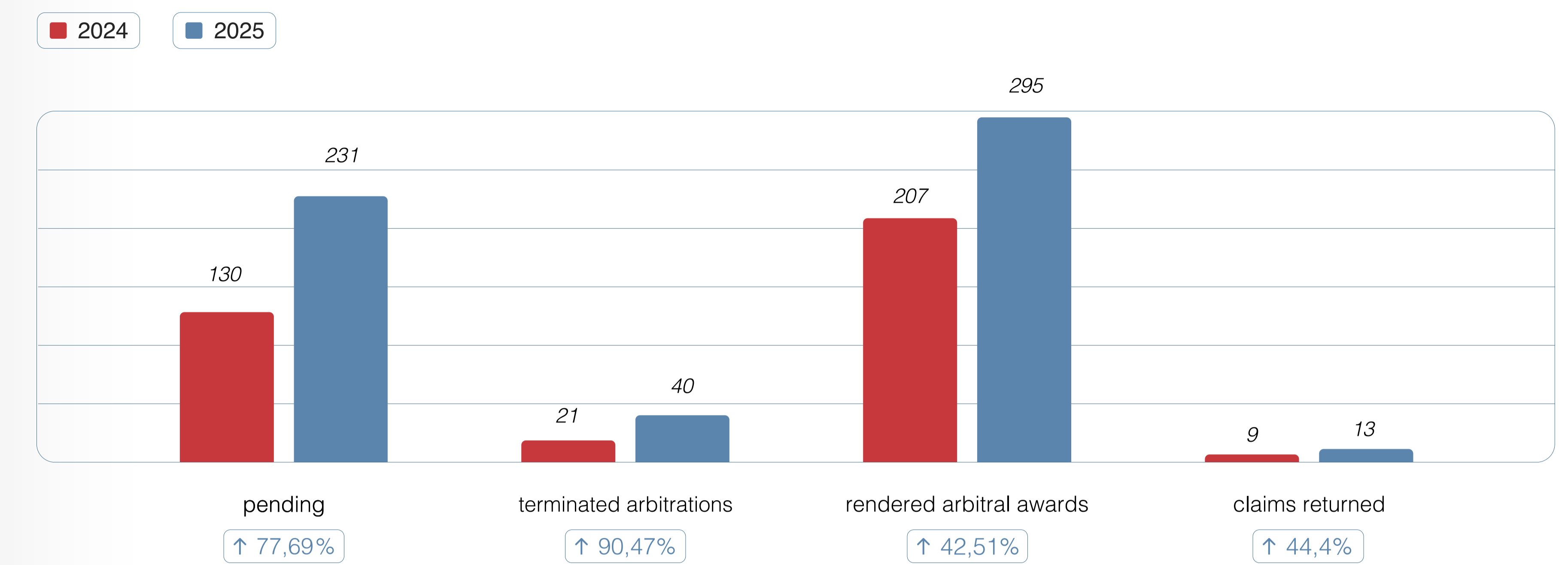

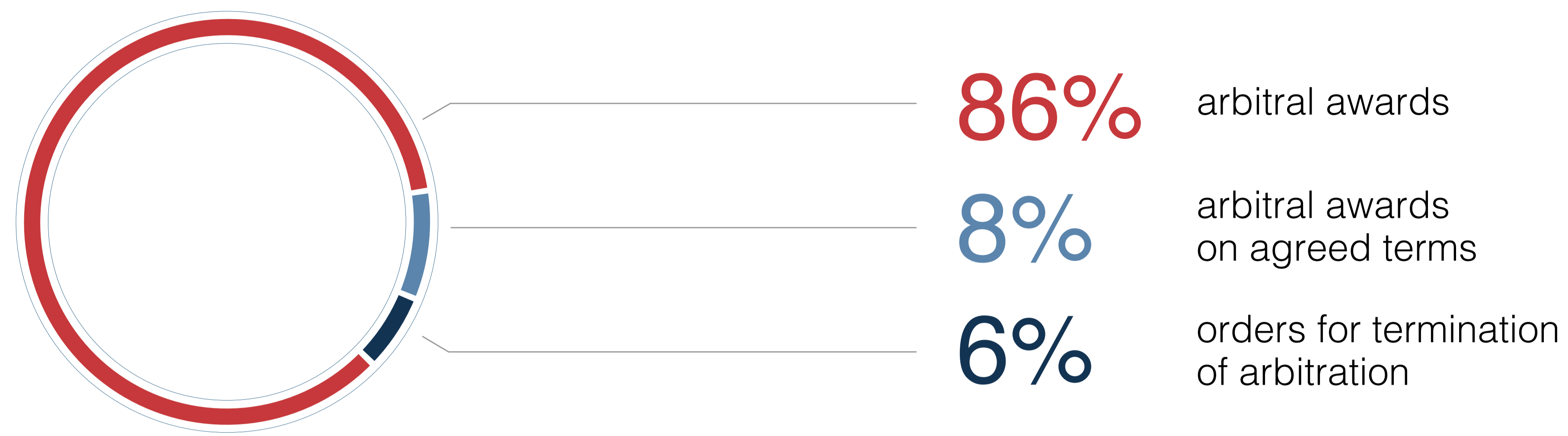

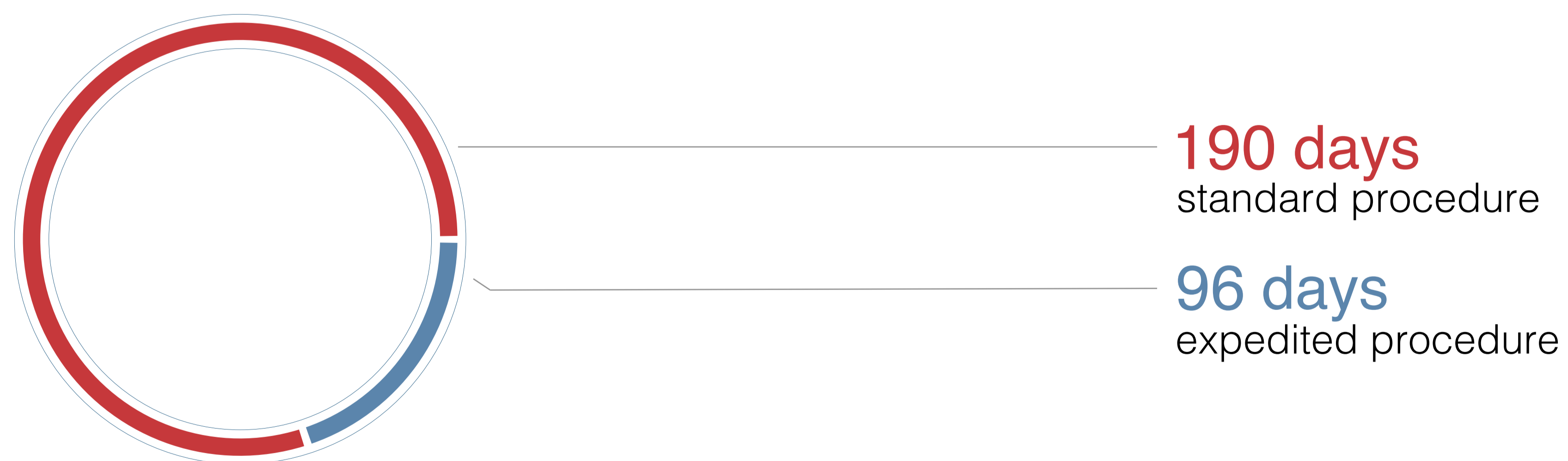
PARTIES` GEOGRAPHY

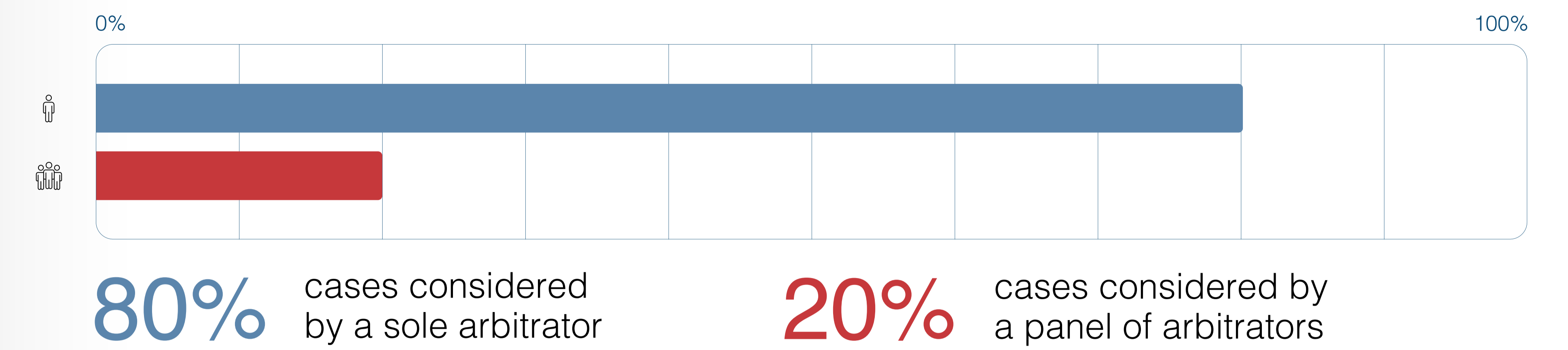
AVERAGE DURATION

From the receipt of the request for arbitration



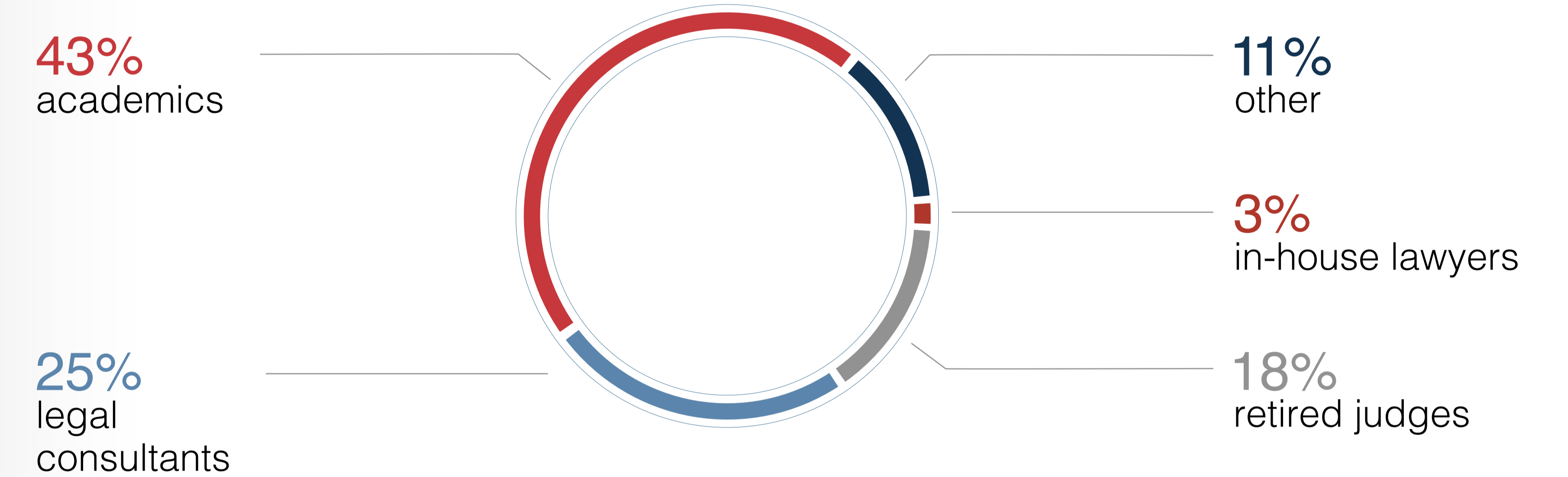
RAC ARBITRATORS

In 2025, 392 cases were referred to arbitral tribunals

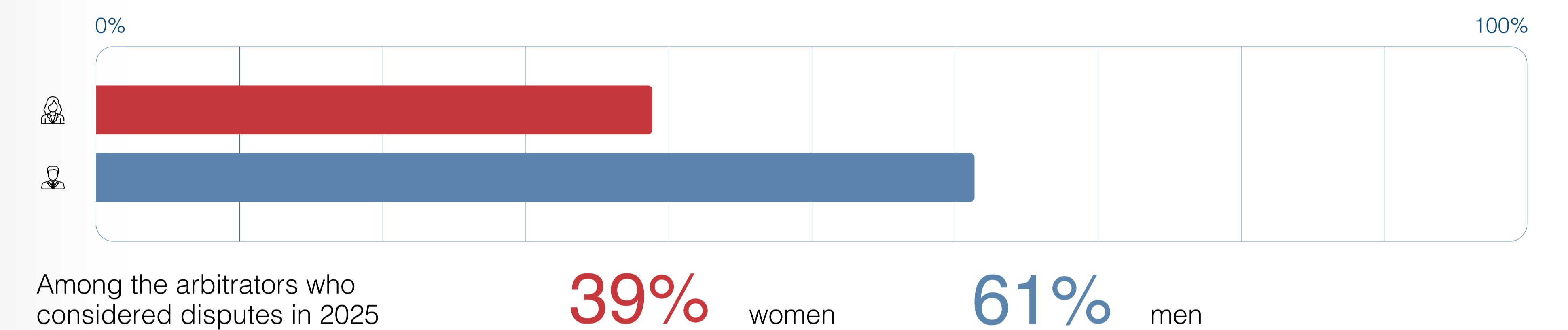

AGE RANGE



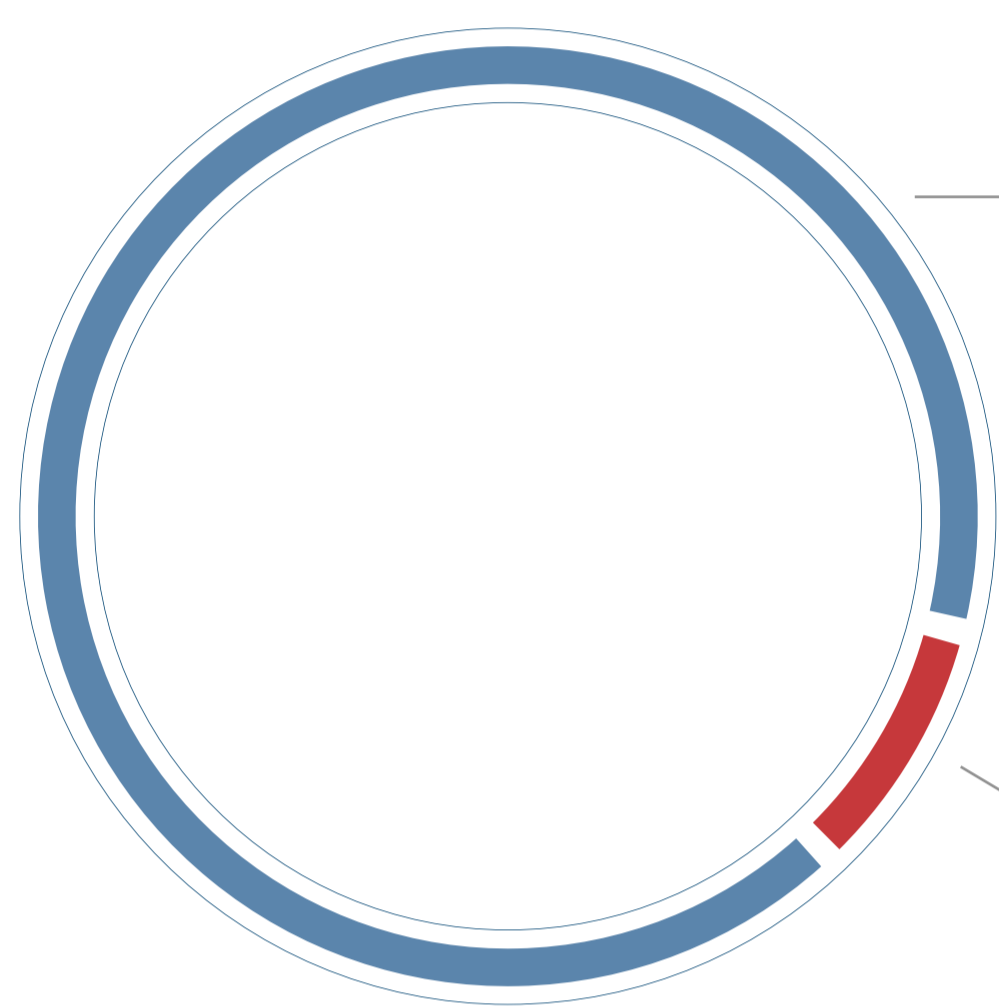

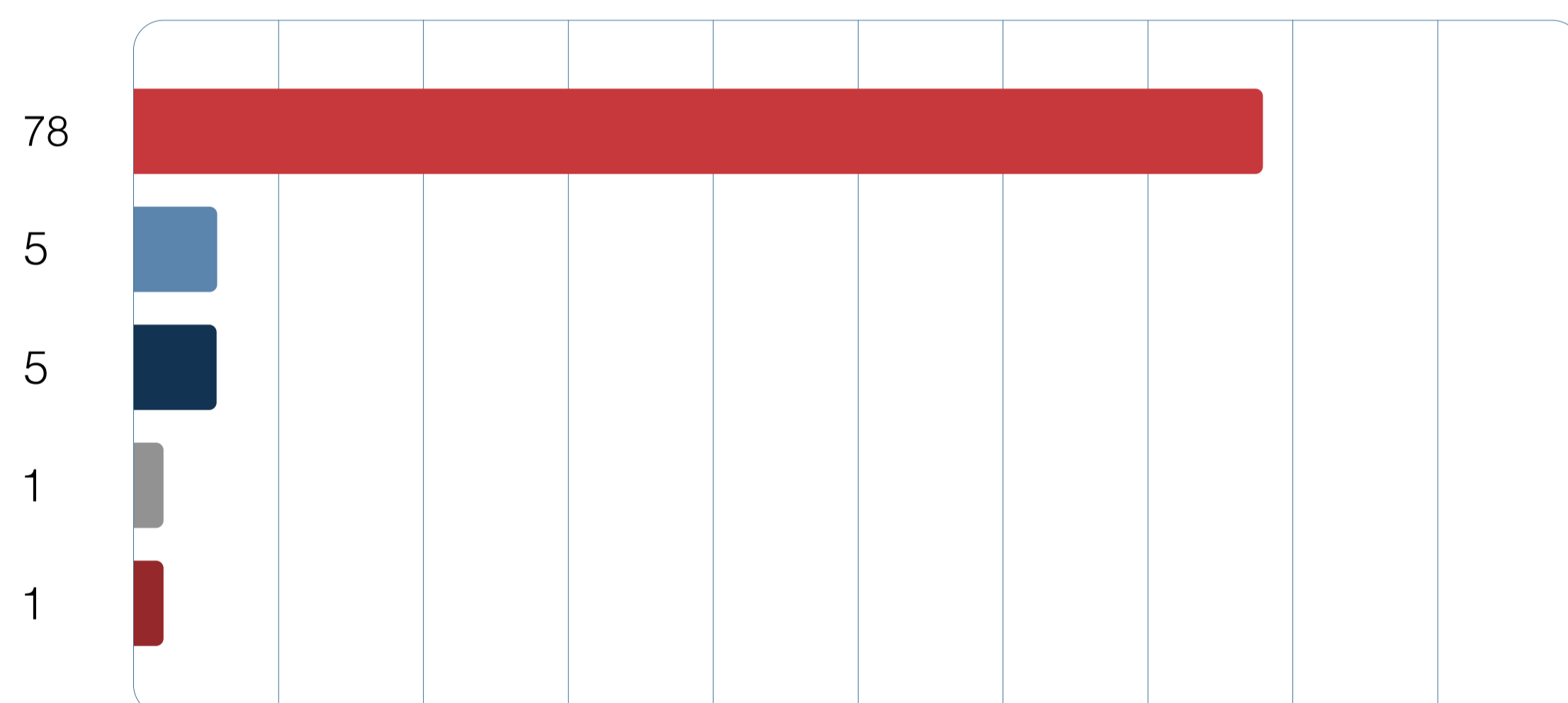
