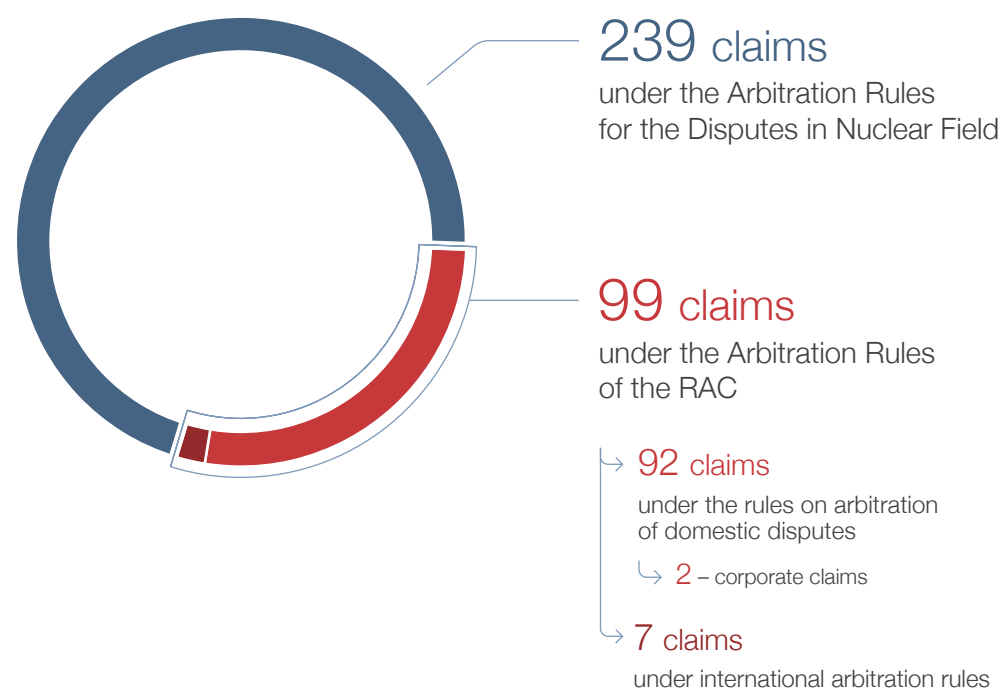

RAC and RIMA Activities in 2021

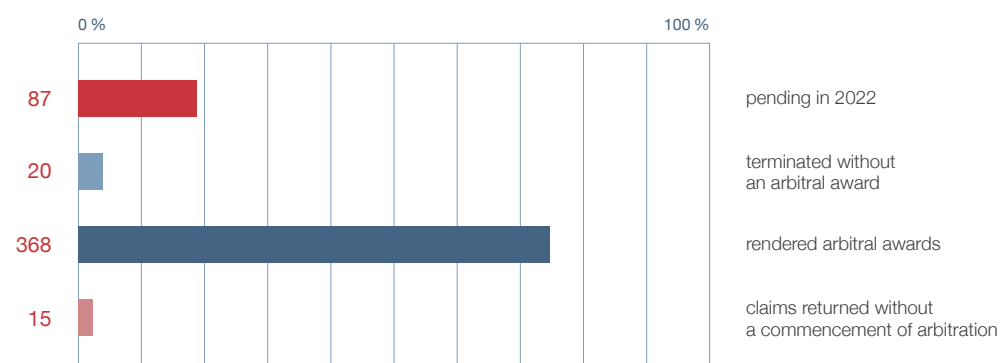

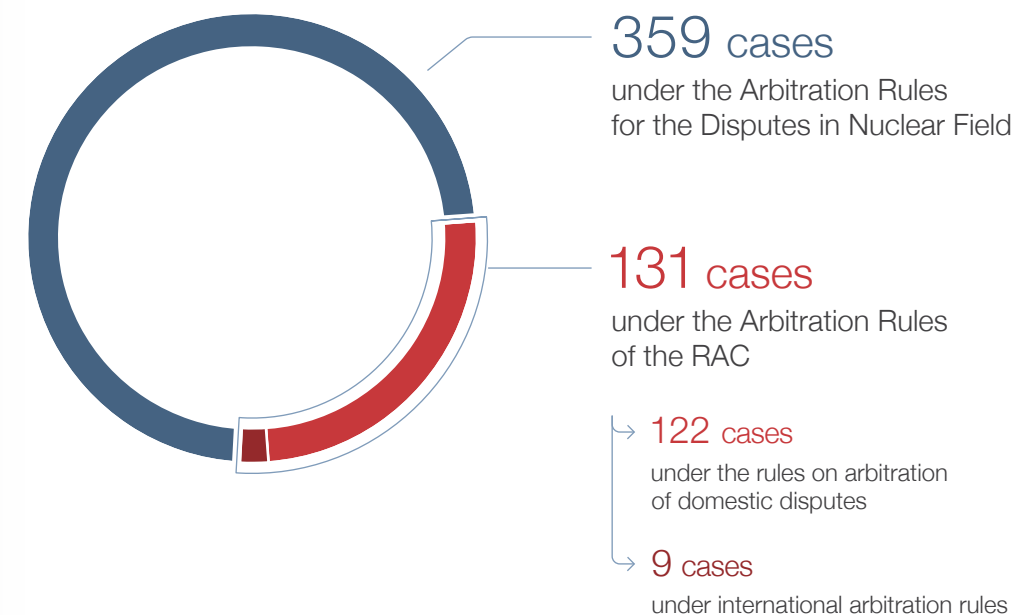

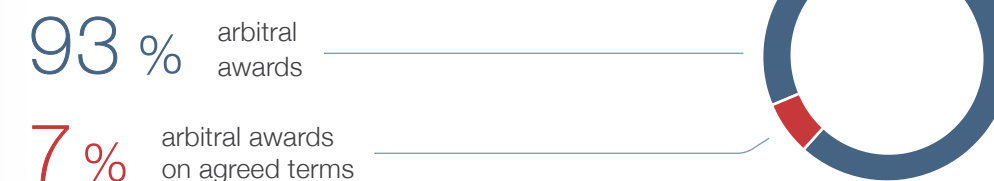

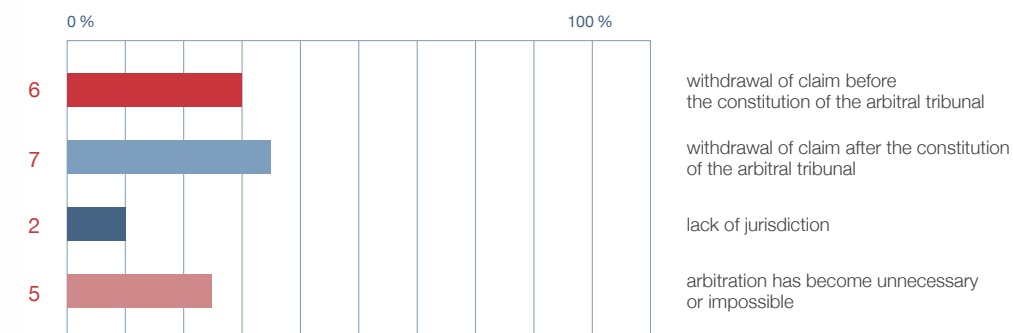

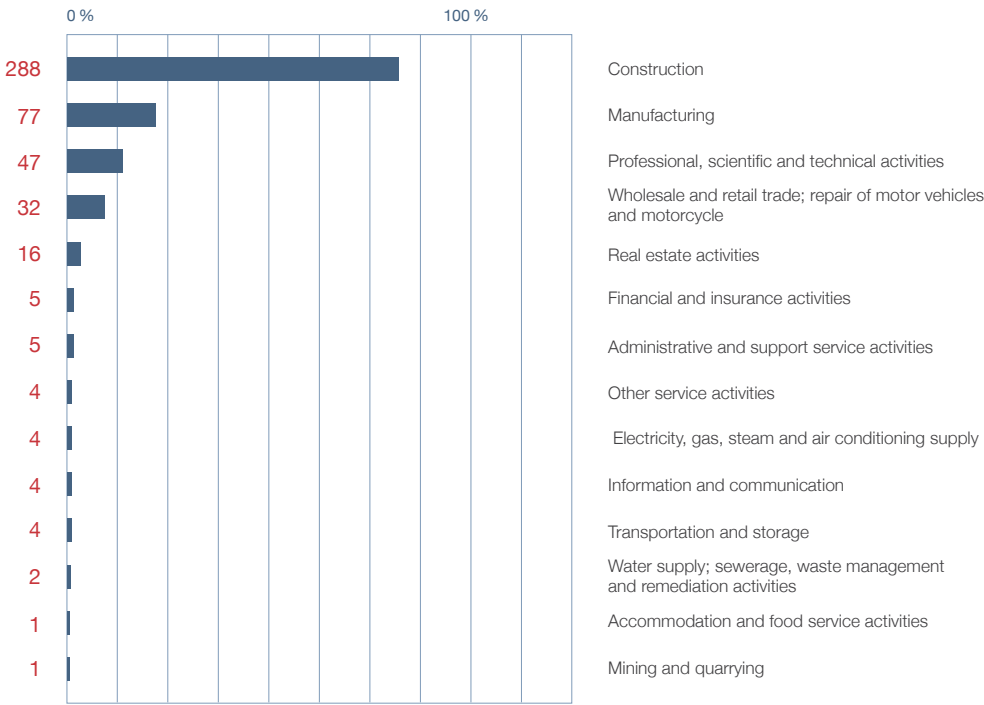

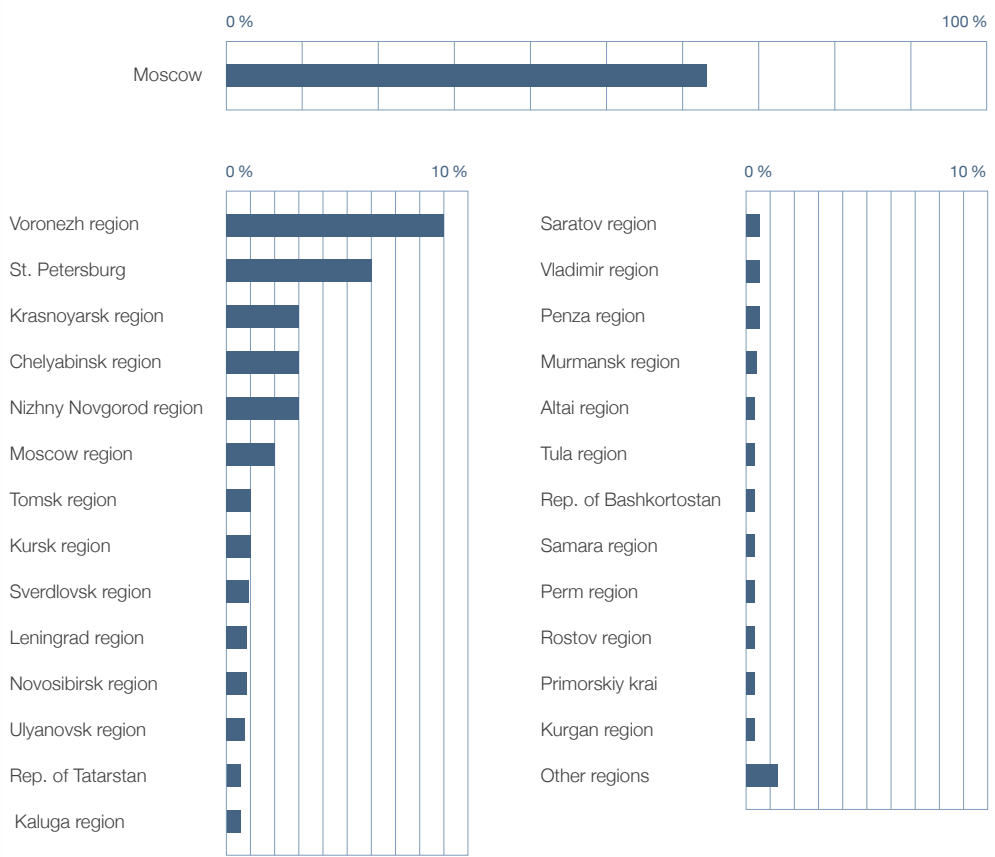

GEOGRAPHY OF THE PARTIES[🔔]

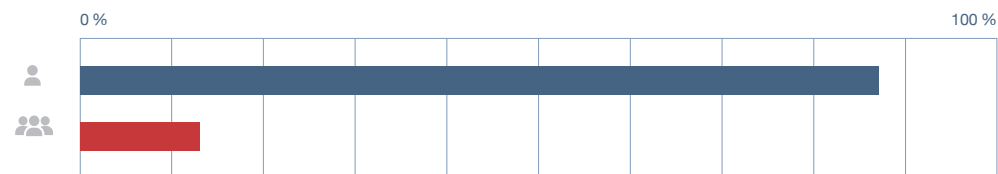

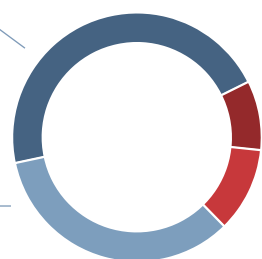

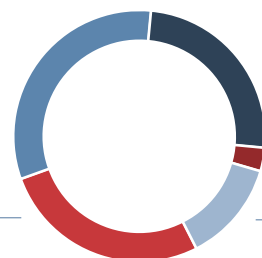

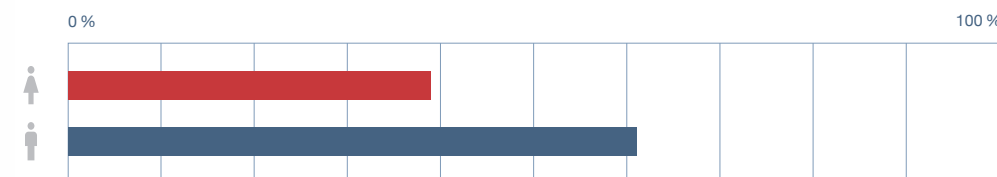

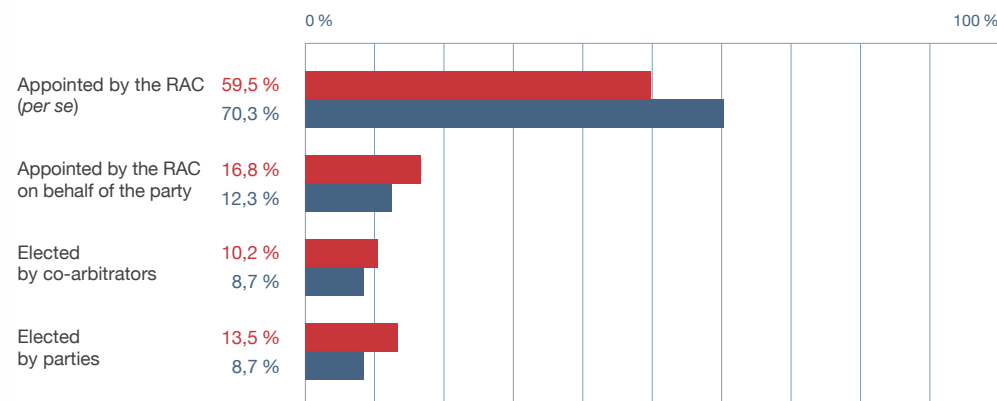
PARTICIPATION OF MEN AND WOMEN AS ARBITRATORS

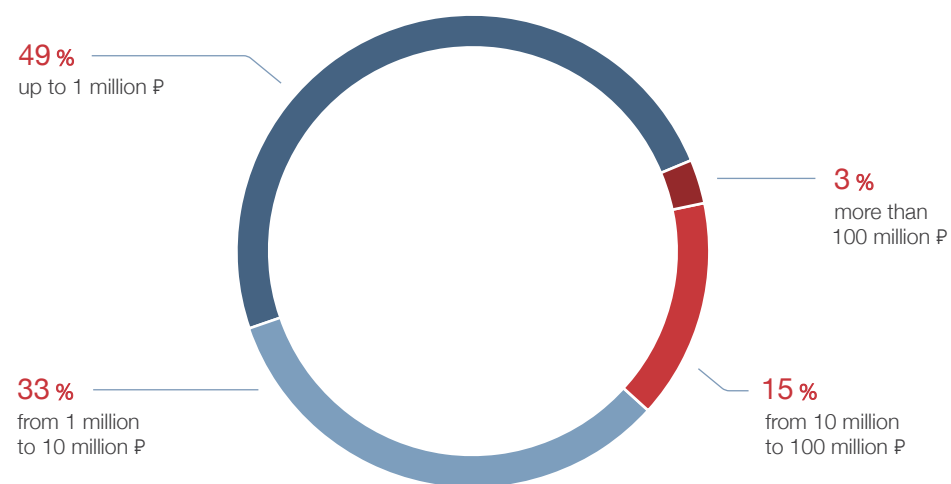

Entire Arbitration Online

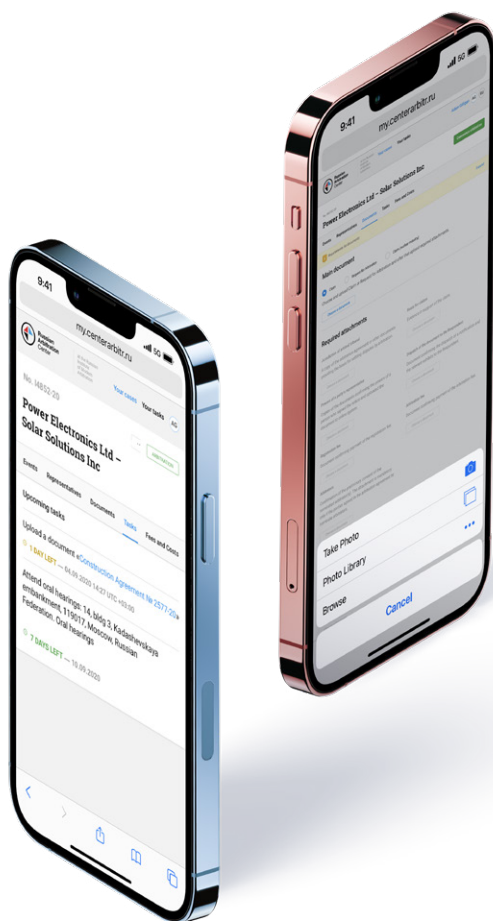
The whole process of arbitration from filing a claim to adoption of an arbitral award could be carried out through the Online System.
